

Frequently Asked Questions **National Elementary Honor Society**

- 1. What grades are involved in the NEHS?**
4th and 5th grade students
- 2. What makes a student eligible to receive a Candidate Form?**
The student must have earned at least 90% in all subjects and all E's in Work Habits and Conduct for the two previous semesters.
- 3. If I received a letter of selection, do I have to accept membership?**
No, however each candidate is asked to respond with the Candidate Form.
- 4. When are the forms due?**
Refer to deadline on Candidate Form (no late forms accepted).
- 5. When does membership begin?**
Membership begins with the formal induction ceremony, held annually in September.
- 6. What cost is involved?**
\$20
- 7. Who is the advisor for NEHS?**
Mrs. Schumacher
- 8. Who makes up the Faculty Council?**
An anonymous group of teachers selected by the Principal
- 9. Why was my child/I not selected?**
This decision was made carefully and came only after a thorough review of your candidacy by the council. A careful review of your records did not result in the majority vote necessary to earn membership.
- 10. How many members are in our chapter?**
A maximum of twenty-five students
- 11. What does NEHS do?**
It develops leadership and servanthood in students that have shown academic excellence and responsibility. We meet once per quarter and participate in two service projects per semester.
