* For your re-registration to be complete and to secure student enrollment, \$100 (non-refundable deposit) of the \$205 registration fee is due by 2/17 with the balance due by 3/24 to avoid a \$45 late fee.

Family Discounts (Kindergarten - 12th grade)	
1st Child	Regular price
2nd Child	10% to both students
3rd Child	18% to all three students
4th Child +	Total tuition charged to families with 4 or more K-12 students will not exceed the sum of the three oldest student's tuition less our 18% discount. This total will then be allocated proportionately to all K-12 students based upon each student's full cost of tuition. (<i>Early Education/Preschool is not included in the family discount</i>)

Registration Refund Policy
After 3/24, the registration fee and re-registration fees are non-refundable.

Tuition Payment Policy
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The tuition for Kindergarten through 12th Grade students will be divided into eleven monthly payments. The first payment is due August 1 and the last payment is due June 1. • Any payment received after the seventh of the month will be considered late and the account will be assessed a \$25 late charge. • If an account becomes more than 60 days past due, the student may not be allowed to attend class until the account is brought current. • There is a \$20 charge on all checks returned by the bank. • Tuition for graduating seniors must be paid before graduation day in order for the student to participate in graduation ceremonies. • If annual tuition is paid in full by the first day of school, the family will receive a three percent discount.
